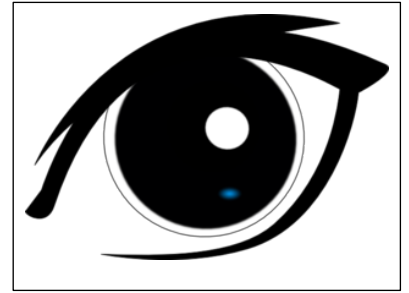

In a world of fashion and hip hop icons; teenagers, young men and women often wonder how to fit in. What does "fit in" mean in our world today?
