Celebrating Resurrection Sunday

Queen Street Baptist Church observed Easter, Apr. 4, with a virtual worship service, the second time since in-person worship was suspended March of last year because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

As part of the seasonal celebration, the Morning Glory and Evening Glory prayers lines used Dr. Glenn Porter's book *Journey With Jesus Through Lent* for devotions. And QSBC partnered with The Chrysler Museum of Art to present the webinar: "From Heartache to Hallelujah!" The presentation featured Amber Garrett, Dr. Lloyd DeWitt and Pastor Porter.
